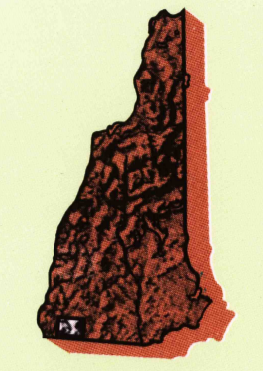


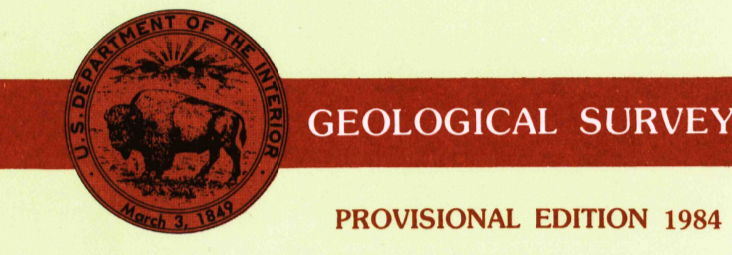
Monadnock Mountain NEW HAMPSHIRE
